BOATER'S DREAM BOCA GRANDE

If you're looking for a full day of adventure, head north to Gasparilla Island and its charming historic village of Boca Grande. Pull into the yacht-full harbor at Boca Grande Marina (formerly Miller's Marina), where you can choose from two waterfront restaurants. If you'd rather hit a local beach café or downtown eatery, rent a bike or golf cart from the



marina - both are allowed on bike paths and downtown city streets. Do a little shopping, tour the vintage architecture, hit the beach, or step into the local boating heritage at the funky, dusty maritime museum at Whidden's Marina. If you're tempted to stay longer, Boca Grande Marina offers overnight docking.

KICK-BACK CABBAGE KEY

Closer and more casual, Cabbage Key Inn welcomes boaters for the ultimate Southwest Florida island experience far away from the mainstream. Order a cold one at the congenial bar, tape your autographed dollar bill to the George Washington-papered walls, relive Jimmy Buffett's Cheeseburger in Paradise fantasy, feed the ducks, take a nature hike, or spend the night in a historic cottage or inn room.



GOOD-TIME GOODLAND

A trio of restaurants, each with more character than the last, rims the mangrove-edged harbor in Goodland, which qualifies as a prototype for "old Florida fishing village." A NAUTICAL STORY RICH IN HISTORY

Hamilton Harbor Yacht Club was built in the tradition of two great Southwest Florida clubs also founded by the Collier family – the Useppa Island Club and the Everglades Rod and Gun Club. These clubs introduced United States Presidents and captains of industry to the rustic hospitality of a new frontier in recreation and sport.

In fact, it was a visit to Useppa Island in 1911 that began Barron Gift Collier's love affair with Southwest Florida. A barrier island off the coast of Lee County, Useppa was the first of what would become an extended series of land purchases by Mr. Collier that would eventually total 1.3 million acres. On Useppa, he created a classic club named The Izaak Walton Fishing Club. Here, tarpon fishing became a passion; Rockefellers and Rothschilds were his guests, as were Gloria Swanson, Shirley Temple and Zane Grey. Although Collier's club was virtually destroyed by a mid-century hurricane, it has now been rebuilt to greet new generations of those seeking the simple elegance and tranquility of Useppa Island.

The Everglades Rod & Gun Club also was a Collier creation. In 1923, while engaged in the building of the Tamiami Trail, he recognized that Everglades City in Southern Collier County was ideally located as a headquarters for the project. As this small fishing village became a boomtown, Collier converted what had been the homestead of the area's founding family into the Rod & Gun Club, a riverfront, wood-paneled haven for hunting and fishing enthusiasts including Ernest Hemingway and Dwight D. Eisenhower.

Part memory and part legacy, this rich past provided a clear roadmap for Hamilton Harbor Yacht Club. Its Old Florida architecture and unaffected style reflect its roots. Its facilities and service mirror the standards set by its founder. And, its respect for the land – some 160 acres of preserve and one and one-half miles of protected shoreline – sustains a family and company commitment that spans generations.

The joys of Florida's outdoors and on-water recreational opportunities can be experienced in their purest form at Hamilton Harbor Yacht Club.

Nature and nautical programs take full advantage of the club's location on the northern boundary of Rookery Bay National Reserve. Comprised of 110,000 acres of pristine mangrove forest, wetlands, uplands and protected estuarine waters, Rookery Bay is a tranquil sanctuary for 150 species of birds and many endangered animals. It's also an internationally renowned paradise for bird watchers, boaters, fisherman, kayakers and nature lovers.

So close yet seemingly so far away, the "Home Waters" of Hamilton Harbor Yacht Club possess a magical allure of adventure and excitement. Rich in natural history and teeming with unique flora and fauna, your coastal playground is just a short boat ride from Naples' premier new marina.

ANGLING OPPORTUNITIES

Truly an angler's paradise, the adjacent inshore and backcountry waters boast a world-class fishery for hard charging trophy game fish. Tempting skills and wills, expect to tangle with snook, redfish and the mighty tarpon employing a variety of tactics and techniques. Try it on your own or have the staff at Hamilton Harbor "hook you up" with a professional guide.

Breaching scenic Gordon Pass, the placid Gulf of Mexico provides a bounty of piscatorial options on the near shore and offshore fishing grounds. Seasonal species such as permit, cobia and king mackerel are top targets through out the region, while the grouper and snapper are always biting.



WILDLIFE ABOUND

Within a few paddles of Hamilton Harbor's marina basin, canoe and kayak enthusiasts enter a coastal ecosystem that is truly a world of its own. As one travels south into the Rookery Bay National Estuarine Reserve, a myriad of mangrove islands, shallow flats, oyster bars and tidal creeks harbor populations of unique bird and wildlife. Rivaling many places on earth, the area literally transforms into a birders mecca during the cooler months of late fall and winter.

Timing is critical in planning a bird watching excursion. Low early morning or late in the day tides provide for optimum viewing as many flats, sand bars and shorelines become exposed allowing an array of wading birds prime foraging.

Don't forget your binoculars and field guide as innumerable herons, egrets, roseate spoonbills and ibis populate the backcountry areas while brown pelicans, hawks, ospreys and bald eagles majestically soar overhead.

More than just birdlife, prepare to observe the occasional whitetail deer, alligator and raccoon traversing the edges of the dense mangrove canopy as bottlenose dolphins and the West Indies manatee complete the adventure.



BOATING BONANZA

Here throughout the coastal region, day trips offer the recreational boater opportunities to experience many activities. Our barrier island Keewaydin affords the perfect setting for family picnics and beachcombing while supporting critical nesting habitat for the piping plover and the loggerhead turtle alike. Remember, though, to keep the island pristine by "leaving no trace."

For those who harness the wind, the consistent warm trade winds of summer and traditional winter off shores provide outstanding conditions to set sail. Under sail in no time, spectacular panoramic views of the historic Naples fishing pier and coastline will make your cruise a true escape.

Simply hopping aboard your vessel and going for a ride will be a great opportunity to treat friends and family to all the waterfront has to offer. Impressive estate homes, tropical on-the-water dining and postcard worthy sunsets are just a sampling of the many highlights.

The first of its kind in the region, the boathouse was built using the innovative tilt-wall concrete construction method. The steel reinforced walls, each weighing 160,000 pounds, were poured into concrete molds, cured and then tilted into place by



a crane. Tilt wall construction gives the boathouse greater strength and durability than the more common pre-engineered metal construction.

The boathouse exceeds building codes and is rated to withstand 150 mph hurricane-force winds, which is notably stronger than the 115 to 140 mph protection typical with standard boat storage facilities along the Gulf Coast.


In addition to storm protection, the Hamilton Harbor boathouse provides comprehensive fire protection. Seven-and-a-quarter-inch concrete walls separate each boat bay to protect against the spread of fire. A high-tech sprinkler system, supported by two artesian wells, disperses about 1,000 gallons of water per minute through multiple sprinkler heads over each boat.

An 84-foot wide center aisle and our 55,000-pound capacity forklift, one of the largest ever made for the marine industry, ensure safer, more efficient handling of even the largest boats.

The Hamilton Harbor boathouse has slips and will accommodate boats up to 55 feet long (depending on weight), 20 feet high and 15 feet wide.

Among the first-class concierge services available to dry slip members are unlimited in and out, customized pre-launch service, discounted fuel, complete freshwater engine flush and a soap wash down and dry. Social membership privileges at the waterfront clubhouse complete the package at this picture perfect yacht club and marina on Naples Bay.

PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT – A HISTORY OF

HISTORY

In the 1870s a handful of pioneering souls – many Confederate soldiers recovering from the Civil War – came by oxcart or sailboat to what was then called Florida's Last Frontier. This area, which would become Naples, was then a watery, sub-tropical tangle that daunted even veteran surveyors, who spoke of "dense swamps" and "ponds full of monstrous alligators".

Barron Gift Collier, an advertising magnate from Memphis, first visited the area in 1911. He fell in love with Southwest Florida and soon bought Useppa Island, just north of Sanibel and Captiva. Collier's enthusiasm for yachting and fishing inspired him to found the Izaak Walton Fishing Club in honor of the 17th century author of *The Compleat Angler*.

In the next dozen years, Collier acquired more than a million acres in Southwest Florida. The state's largest landowner, he gained a reputation not only for bold land purchases but for careful development.

Collier's commitment to the future of our region can be traced through his many contributions, among them railroads, mail service, utilities, and even completion of the Tamiami Trail linking Lee and Dade counties. For his influence and investment in the state's future, the state named Collier County in his honor on May 8, 1923.


Half a century later, in 1976, Barron Gift Collier's grandson, Miles C. Collier, founded a new investment and land development company, Collier Enterprises. Today, this private firm continues very much in the Collier tradition of responsible land stewardship.

CONSERVATION

Part memory and part legacy, this rich past set a course for Hamilton Harbor Yacht Club. Its old Florida architecture reflects its roots. Its facilities and services reflect the highest standards of excellence and its respect for the land reflects a family and company commitment that spans generations.

At Hamilton Harbor, some 160 acres of natural wetlands, uplands, and one and one-half miles of mangrove-lined waterfront have been protected and enhanced at the yacht club's location on the edge of the Rookery Bay National Reserve. Important archaeological sites on the property have been identified and preserved.

In partnership with the City of Naples, Hamilton Harbor has implemented a sea grass bed protection program. We have deepened the channel and installed new channel markers and signs to help boaters avoid damaging sensitive sea grasses.

In addition, to help restore natural tidal flows through nearby mangrove areas, we designed and built the sea wall surrounding our marina to be submerged at high tide.

COSTA DE LA FLORIDA

Hamilton Harbor is also certified as a Clean Marina – one of a small percentage of Florida marinas to meet the demanding standards of the state's voluntary Clean Marina Program. Certification signifies that we're doing everything possible to ensure that our waters are clean and safe.

COMMUNITY

Collier Enterprises has provided several community benefits at Hamilton Harbor:

- A public fuel dock and bait shop
- Improved boat access to Bayview Park through a deeper canal and channel
- A marine construction loading facility
- Improved water quality runoff from streets in surrounding neighborhoods
- A dock for law enforcement patrol vessel, allowing rapid response on the water

In addition to Hamilton Harbor Yacht Club, Collier Enterprises has developed Collier's Reserve, The Old Collier Golf Club, and other distinguished projects. The excellence and sensitivity of our development approach have brought public recognition and environmental awards from organizations such as Audubon International and the Council for Sustainable Florida.
